JUNIORS (8-17j) Poule system

**SENIORS (+18j) : Gents -70 kg, +70 kg, + (80 kg Open category)
: Ladies – Open category.**

SYSTEM JUNIORS

- For the youth the poulesystem stays so they can get the necessary experience.
- There will be fought on base of the Kyokushinkai competition rules with matched contact.
(Depending on the age there will be more contact)
- with mandatory protection for **Juniors** Cross, head, tibia and gloves and for the girls breast protection with cups (no plate). mouth protection is an instigation.
- Below 16 years of age, straight kicks to the facies are forbidden like (mae-yoko-ushiro-kakato-geri). Kicks like mawashi and ushiro-mawashi geri are allowed.

The layout of the poules is as follows:

(8 - 9 years)---(10-11 years)---(12-13 years)---(14-15 years)---(16-17 years)

- These categories will be graded on base of sex, weight, age and kyu of the fighter, with a maximum weight difference of 5 kg (for as far as registrations allows us)
- The length of the competitions is 1,5 minute. (Can be changed by the tournament leaders)
- The minimum count of participants per poule is 3.

SYSTEEM SENIORS

- For the Seniors are bound to the classic Kyokushinkai competition rules.
- Categories with direct loss.
- The length of the competitions is 2 minutes, followed by 1 elongation of 2 minutes.
- Leg and cross protection are mandatory, head protection is not allowed.
- There is no protection allowed like bandages or tape without permission of the doctor or organization.

GENERAL RULES

-The competitions are accessible for each karateka (or near discipline) of each style or nationality that matches the next conditions:

Liabilities

- The signing of the statement by parents or legal fosterparents (Juniors) or the fighter himself (Seniors) which knows the Kyokushinkai competitions rules and dismisses the referees and/or organizers of each responsibility. Legal insurance for practicing a martial art.
- The karatekas must bring the competition book of their Federation.

Hygiene

- All nails of fingers and toes must be short and taken care of.
- This also for the total hygiene (body and clothes)

Coaches

The coaches are expected to make their fighters and the crowd to act sportive. At the mat there's only one coach allowed.

Registrations

- To make sure that this is all done in an acceptable time, there will be a **"registration maximum"** this year.
- Weighing between **8h30** and **10h00** (after this time all incoming registrations are dismissed)
- **Attention:** It's only control weighing because the poules are set up in front.
- A karateka that weighs less or more could be dismissed.
- **Can we ask to send the registrations BEFORE May 4th**

- Per team maximum 2 coaches can enter for free (in case of 3 or more fighters are registered)
- The income price for public will cost 6 €. Children -8 years for free.
